

3rd Grade-- Origami Foxes

Teacher Notes:

- When folding head, have a right angle

Directions:

1. Write name on back of blue paper with crayon
2. Fold orange squares into a fox following demonstration
3. Add fox's face with sharpie
4. Tear dark and light green paper for your grass
5. Glue to paper
6. Tear light blue paper for distant mountains
7. Glue to paper
8. Tear purple paper for the mountains
9. Glue to paper
10. Add oil pastel details (grass, weeds, trees, clouds, shadows)
11. Glue down foxes onto your landscape (smallest further away)

Learning Targets:

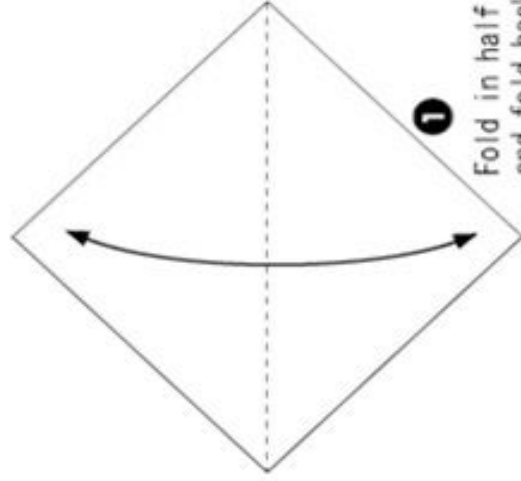
- Fold paper into a origami fox

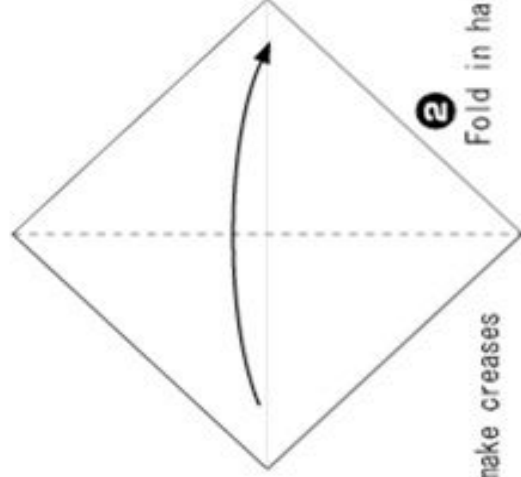
- create an origami fox following step by step directions.
- create a landscape with oil pastel and paper collage.





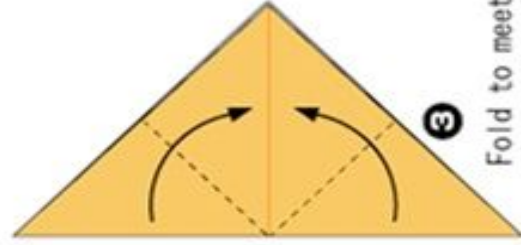

Fold in half to make creases and fold back



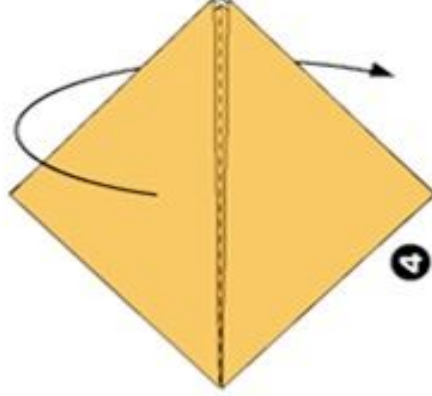

Fold in half



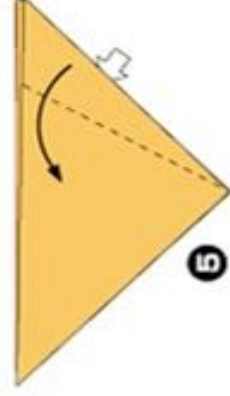

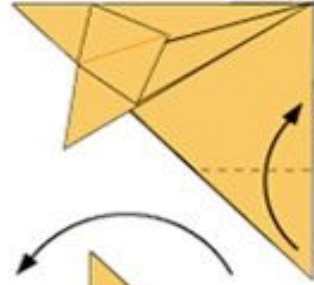

Open the top part and flatten



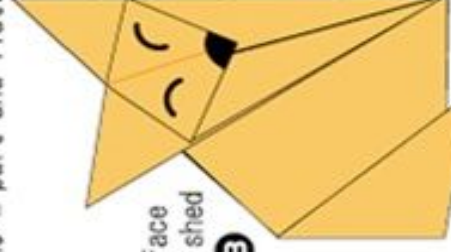
